



School PE Program 2011-2012

Who can participate?

All Public, Private and Home Schools are able to participate in our Physical Education Program. Students in grades K - 12 are welcome. Students must be at least 7 years old to snowboard.

When is the program available?

The PE program is offered throughout the winter season (December through April) any day that we are open Friday to Monday when school is in session, Tuesday is an option if the group is over 50 students. The PE Program rates are *not available* on days when students are out of school, including holidays, weekends. Home Schools should use their local Public School Calendars for planning purposes.

How much does it cost?

The cost depends on the Equipment that they choose to learn on. Special rates are also available to teachers and chaperones. You'll find our current rate sheet enclosed. Fees for your Students, teachers and chaperones can be paid in advance or paid at the resort upon arrival in a single transaction, either by cash, check or purchase order, or credit card (we accept Visa, MasterCard and Amex).

What does the PE program include?

The fees include a *2-Hour Group Lesson*, Full Day use of *Rental Equipment*, and an all access *lift pass*. Rates also include a sack lunch and a soda.

We are happy to send a representative to your school prior to your visit. This representative can speak to your students about preparation and safety issues, and will answer their many questions.

What happens on a PE day?

- School groups should arrive at the resort car park between 9 and 9:30 am. You will be given an orientation and safety briefing, and then broken up into lesson groups by ability level. Each student receives a lift ticket, and retrieves his or her pre-organized rental equipment.
- *ALL students, regardless of ability, are required to take the 2-Hour Group Lesson.* This lesson will commence at 10:30 am. Subject to all Students having their equipment and being dressed and ready to go.
- We may offer advanced skiers and riders the chance to take their lessons at 1.30 pm. In this case, the advanced students are permitted to ski or ride for the morning (ensuring that they make it back for their lesson).
- At the end of their lesson, students will be given lunch at around 12.30 pm. After this, students may practice their skills for the rest of the day. Students will be told which lifts they can ride based on their skill level. The purpose of restricting some students to certain lifts is to ensure their safety and the safety of others.

How does our School sign up for the Program?

You should call us as soon as possible to reserve your trip date(s).

Please Remember, the number of students that we can accommodate each day is limited to 80 students, the sooner you call, the more options you'll have.

When you call, you'll need to already have a good idea of:

- When you're planning to come
- How many kids and what grades
- When you'd like to schedule your in-school safety presentation
- And have several alternate dates as backup.
